
Testimony Regarding Unauthorized Use of Stakeholder Donations

To Whom It May Concern,

I, Mushtaq Khan, am providing this testimony to formally document a conversation I had with Mr. Faiyaz Hassan regarding the use of stakeholder donation funds entrusted to ICCD.

Mr. Hassan informed me that he had taken an amount of \$250 from donation money—without prior approval from the ICCD Board—with the intention of helping a friend or family member overseas. During our discussion, he asked me to approve this action and implied that it should be acceptable to continue using stakeholder donations in this manner.

I responded firmly and advised Mr. Hassan that such use of donation funds is inappropriate and unacceptable. Stakeholder donations are a trust, given to us with the expectation that they will be used wisely and ethically to support the needs of our local community. Diverting these funds for personal or overseas assistance violates that trust and undermines the integrity of our organization.

For the record, I reported this matter to the ICCD Board to clarify that I do not condone or support this behavior, and to ensure transparency regarding my position. I believe this practice must be stopped immediately to preserve the credibility and accountability of ICCD.
